The Academy of Professional Aestheticians (APAes) is an international professional institution that seeks to provide high quality, relevant professional development programs for aestheticians through strategic partnership with various higher tertiary institutions, professional bodies, industries and companies in the world that are intellectually stimulating and appropriate to aestheticians and companies or consortia of companies.

It offers the **Certified Practising Aesthetician (CPAes) Qualification** course for students that interested to prepare themselves for careers in the beauty and wellness industry.

Students who have successfully completed all the course requirements will be awarded the CPAes Qualification by the Academy of Professional Aestheticians (APAes) which can be used as **\*academic entry requirement** into the University of Canberra (an Australian Government owned university in the capital of Australia) undergraduate degree programs and as follows:

- Bachelor of Human Nutrition (686AA)
- Bachelor of Applied Science in Human Biology (365AE)
- Bachelor of Coaching Science (684AA)
- Bachelor of Medical Science (660AA)

*\*All foreign students are required to take the IELTS test conducted by the IDP Australia at the end of the CPAes Qualification course and obtained a score of 6 and above to be eligible to study in Australia for the degree programs with the University of Canberra.*

### **CERTIFIED PRACTISING AESTHETICIAN QUALIFICATION COURSE (12 mths) Intakes in January, April, July and October**

Certified Practising Aesthetician (CPAes) Qualification course is an in-depth program that provide knowledge in the areas of general sciences that you need to know to keep you and your clients safe and healthy; skin sciences that offers clear, up-to-date knowledge on every aspect of the skin; the principles of aesthetics procedures focus on actual practices performed by the aestheticians; and the nutrition science that enhance the competency skills of aestheticians.

#### **Scholarship Features**

- The scholarship shall be in the form of wavier of full tuition fee (\$6000) for the Certified Practising Aestheticians Qualification Course.
- Successful applicants will be required to pay S\$2000 for course notes, and assessment fees (\$500 per part - Part 1: General Science, Part 2: Skin Science, Part 3: Principle of Aesthetics Procedures and Part 4: Nutrition Science).
- The scholarship shall be for the duration of the course. **It does not cover the remodule fee (\$500 per part).** Student that fails the first attempt of the examination in any of the part will be given a **re-examination at no cost.** However, if the student fails the re-examination, s/he needs to remodule the part in future term.
- On all matters pertaining to the scholarship, the decision(s) of the Emmanuel Scholarship Committee shall be final and binding.
- Terms and conditions of the scholarship may be modified and amended from time to time as deemed appropriate by the Emmanuel Scholarship Committee.
- In exceptional cases, scholarships may be withdrawn at anytime in the event of gross misconduct, failure to meet the required academic grades and or achieve less than 90 percent of the class attendance.
- Scholarship holders must pass all examinations and assessments, and maintain good academic standing.
- In the event the student withdraws from the course before completion, scholarship holders will require reimbursing the scholarship awarded.
